

DESCRIPTION OF THE COMPETITION

DIALOG – Aboriginal Peoples Research and Knowledge Network – is an interuniversity, interinstitutional, interdisciplinary, and international cluster; it is funded by the Québec Research Funds – Société et Culture (program for strategic clusters), and the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council (Partnership Program).

For its 20th anniversary, DIALOG is launching the PITAPANN (morning light) Competition for Indigenous students¹ having completed undergraduate studies (or in the process of doing so) and who would like to begin postgraduate studies by spring 2022.

These scholarships in the amount of \$5,000 each aim to support the university trajectory of Indigenous students in Québec universities.

Eligibility

These scholarships are reserved for Indigenous students whose postgraduate studies shall be directed jointly by two regular member researchers of the DIALOG Network. Only one scholarship per student shall be attributed.

Evaluation of application

The evaluation shall be conducted by two members of the Executive Office according to the following criteria:

- Proposed research project
- Respect for ethical rules and guiding principles in Indigenous research
- Quality of the university record
- Letter of recommendation

Instructions for submission of nomination

- Complete the form on the following page
- Attach a resumé
- Provide a summary of the proposed project: 1 p. max.
- Include a letter of recommendation from the future supervisor
- Provide a current university transcript
- Provide proof of official registration for postgraduate studies

Due date and submission of file

Nominations may be submitted anytime in 2021. Application files must be sent to the following address: reseadialog@ucs.inrs.ca

Candidate's obligation

Recipients will be invited to present their project during a public activity with DIALOG.

Terms and conditions

The scholarship shall be paid at the end of the first session completed.
